After Shaleni left I thought life would be a lot less work, and in a way it was, but on the other hand I had several ladies that were in need of a friend and one even suicidal. I spent a few weeks praying every night because that's all I could do. I would wake up hoping i would not get the news that this lady died. Then in August three Spanish ladies came to me asking if I would teach them the bible. We started meeting every Monday going through the book of Timothy. The lady who was

suicidal decided to join us and said the only way she could get out of her depression was to focus on God. I am glad she realized that and she is slowly coming back to church again.

With all that going on I did not get my brochures out for the ladies retreat, but God has a way of getting the ladies there that He wants there. This was our fifth annual ladies retreat (in Oct) and fifty ladies were there. The spirit of the Lord was really moving and we talked about doing these retreats more frequently.

Fostering Updates:

Since my last update in May Shaleni left (June 1st) and is now living with her grandmother. We have seen her two times since then and her grandmother has been enjoying having her around, despite the work of dealing with a very active two year old.

Tyrell turned one at the end of august. He came to us when he was four months and was going to stay for two months. He is going on 15 months now, and is up for adoption. The social worker is checking to see if I can adopt him (as a single parent) and I am praying to determine God's will in this. I am torn

between giving Cory the brother he wants & keeping my house open for emergency cases.
