Right now she is helping with youth group in our church as well as takes time to hang out with the teens on our street.

Wally and Kathy Chopee have once again returned to Belize to serve where God directs them. They have come yearly since 2010 and have also made many friends over the time. They had a rough start as they both got sick the first week of being here. Praising God for the healing He is doing in them.

God blessed us with extra car seats so I could safely buckle in the little ones when I drive. The only thing is when I buckle in my three little ones there is only room for one other person in the vehicle. The truck has been a blessing in getting us where we need to go but with extra children and friends coming down we just do not have enough room for all go out together. I have been talking to different people that know more about vehicles then I do. I wanted to know which vehicle would stand up to the rough roads we have here but also have enough seats for this family that God has placed in my life. When I talk about my family we have Marisol and her two children that come to church with us and Abigail who is living with us right now as well.
